This academic year 2019-20 we have

- Supported 23,156 pupils being taught outside (since June 2019).
- An additional 48 schools have registered to be part of the community of Forest Schools in Northern Ireland.
- 22 families have participated in our Forest School Family programme.
- An average of 20 children per day attend our cross-community Clondeboye Nature Rangers programme.
- A school or nursery visit Clondeboye Estate every week to experience Learning Without Walls.
