Use of equipment	Staff Teachers Pupils	NIFSA will have own kit bag and only use their kit bag. Schools will have their own kit bag and only use their kit bag.	Make sure the schools have enough kit in the bag to carry out the sessions.	All staff	On-going
First Aid	Staff Teachers Pupils	Schools will be required to carry out any first aid needed. There will be a first aid kit in the kitbag.	Make sure NIFSA staff have correct PPE in case they are required to help.	All staff	On-going
Uniform	Staff	NIFSA staff will change and wash uniform each day so no cross contamination between sessions.	Addition uniforms to be purchased to accommodate extra washing.	All staff	On-going

Sickness	Staff	<p>If a NIFSA staff member is displaying any Covid-19 symptoms they will stay at home for the required period of time.</p> <p>If symptoms develop whilst at work the staff member will be required to go home and seek medical attention.</p>	<p>Staff to check temperature each morning before going to work.</p> <p>If symptoms develop NIFSA will contact school that staff member has been in contact with.</p>	Manager /All staff	On-going
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
